

Academic and Classroom Misconduct Disciplinary Sanctions Policy 04:02:00

The College has developed the following regulations that are intended to govern student conduct on the campuses.
This is an annotated version. Please refer to the policy for detailed information.

Violations

1. Physical and/or verbal abuse, threats, hazing and/or intimidation, or harm inflicted on self
2. Disorderly conduct. Any individual or group behavior that is abusive, obscene, lewd, indecent, violent, excessively noisy, or disorderly, or that unreasonably disturbs other groups or individuals
3. Obstruction of or interference with Pellissippi State activities or facilities
4. Misuse of or damage to property
5. Theft, misappropriation, or unauthorized sale of property
6. Misuse of documents or identification cards
7. Firearms and other dangerous weapons
8. Explosives, fireworks, and flammable material
9. Alcoholic beverages, illegal drugs or drug paraphernalia
10. Public Intoxication
11. Gambling
12. Financial irresponsibility
13. Unacceptable conduct in disciplinary proceedings
14. Failure to cooperate with Pellissippi State officials

15. Violation of general rules and regulations
16. Attempts, aiding and/or abetting to commit listed offences
17. Violations of state or federal laws
18. Violation of imposed disciplinary sanctions
19. Sexual battery or rape as defined by state law
20. Harassment or retaliation
21. Academic misconduct. Plagiarism, cheating
22. Unauthorized duplication or possession of keys
23. Litter
24. Pornography
25. Abuse of computer resources and facilities
26. Unauthorized access to college facilities and/or grounds
27. Providing false information
28. Unauthorized surveillance
29. Smoking violations
30. Violations of specific academic program handbooks

Disciplinary Sanctions

Upon determination that a student or student organization has violated any of the disciplinary offences set forth in these regulations, the following disciplinary sanctions may be imposed:

- (a) Restitution
- (b) Warning
- (c) Reprimand
- (d) Service to the College or community
- (e) Specified educational/counseling program
- (f) Apology
- (g) Fines
- (h) Restriction
- (i) Probation
- (k) Expulsion
- (l) Revocation of admission, degree or credential
- (m) Interim suspension
- (n) Any alternate sanction deemed necessary and appropriate to address the misconduct
